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## Pretzels

Baked, salted, and dried harder than bread. Water is the enemy; a soft pretzel is a different food with a different life.

## How long it keeps

Unopened, this keeps **9 months** — which is what puts it on [the long shelf](#).

Counted from the day you bought it. Figures are the **USDA FSIS FoodKeeper** table's, for unopened storage at room temperature; FoodKeeper counts a month as 30 days.
