

# Tamarind paste

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### ingredients

- [Almond oil](#)
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- [Black bean sauce](#)
- [Corn syrup](#)
- [Grapeseed oil](#)

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## Tamarind paste

Tamarind pulp, sour and sticky. Acidic enough for a year on the shelf and a good deal longer in a fridge.

### How long it keeps

Unopened, this keeps **12 months** — which is what puts it on [the long shelf](#).

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As sold

Unopened, in the cupboard

Once opened

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as sold

**6–12 months**

6 months

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Counted from the day you bought it. Figures are the **USDA FSIS FoodKeeper** table's, for unopened storage at room temperature; FoodKeeper counts a month as 30 days.

The table was not pulled from USDA — fsis.usda.gov answers 403 to non-browser clients from this machine — so it came from a mirror of the data.gov dataset and its vintage is unverified. Treat a single figure as indicative, not as a use-by date.
