American Plum	Prunus americana & hybrids	2-4	Jams, jelly, breeding	Canada Plum, Alderman, Patterson Pride, Brookgold
Plumcots/Pluots	Hybrid (Plum x Apricot)	5-7	Fresh eating	Various hybrids
Cherry-plums	Hybrid varieties	3-5
