Cyanocitta cristata is a member of the crows, jays, and magpies family (*Corvidae*), and one of the 454 species on the official Ohio bird list.

Ohio difficulty code	1
Ohio status	not listed

Finding it. Difficulty code 1 means it is readily found within expected habitat during at least one season.
