Red Phalarope

Phalaropus fulicarius is a member of the sandpipers and allies family (*Scolopacidae*), and one of the 454 species on the official Ohio bird list.

Scientific name	<i>Phalaropus fulicarius</i>
Family	Sandpipers and Allies — <i>Scolopacidae</i>
Ohio difficulty code	4
Ohio status	not listed

Finding it. Difficulty code 4 means it is reported annually but easily missed, even with special effort.
